

# Ranbir Kapoor's 'Animal' gets A certificate

Chennai, Nov 24: Ranbir Kapoor's film, 'Animal', is all set to hit theatres on December 1, and we are absolutely excited. Ahead of its premiere, the Central Board of Film Certification (CBFC) granted the film an 'A' certificate. Its runtime is also revealed to be more than 3 hours! The movie, helmed by Sandeep Reddy Vanga, also features Rashmika Mandanna, Anil Kapoor and Bobby Deol in key roles.



'Animal', directed by Sandeep Reddy Vanga, explores the father-son relationship between Ranbir and Anil's characters. The filmmaker took to his official Twitter account to reveal that the film has been granted an 'A' certificate by the CBFC. Additionally, the runtime of 'Animal' is 3 hours and 21 minutes.

After 'Kabir Singh', 'Animal' is Sandeep Reddy Vanga's second Bollywood film. It is slated for a theatrical release on December 1, and will clash with Vicky Kaushal's 'Sam Bahadur.' The film was earlier scheduled to release in August, but due to a clash with Sunny Deol's 'Gadar 2', Akshay Kumar's 'OMG 2' and Rajinikanth's 'Jailer', the director postponed the date.

# Venice to charge entry fee from April 2024

Venice, Nov 24: Venice will start testing a daily admission fee and cap on visitor access to its famous canals from next April, in what the Italian city's mayor hailed as the world's first such scheme.

The move is aimed at managing the flow of tourists on spring holidays and some summer weekends when visitor numbers are at their peak, local authorities said during a press conference on Thursday.

"It is the first time in the world that you do something like this, you make a city bookable," Mayor Luigi Brugnaro said.

The restrictions will apply from 0830 to 1600 local time, initially for a total of 29 days and cover most weekends



from April 25 to mid July next year.

Travellers will have to book their visit online and pay 5 euros (\$5.45) to obtain a QR code that will be checked at specific entry points and will grant them access to the city's historic

quarters. Restrictions will not apply to the lagoon's smaller islands, such as Murano, famous for its glass-making industry.

Potential sanctions will range from 50 to 310 euros will be imposed on those failing to comply

with the measure. Residents and people who were born in Venice as well as students, workers and home owners in the city will be exempt from paying and booking a slot, councillor Michele Zuin said.

# Rlys increases speed of 30 long-distance trains



Chennai, Nov 24: The Central Railway (CR) has increased the speed of 30 long-distance mail and express trains to up to 130 kmph from Wednesday onwards. These trains include the LTT-Hatia-LTT SF bi-weekly express, LTT-Visakhapatnam-LTT SF weekly express, LTT-Puri-LTT SF weekly express, and several others, running across various CR routes.

The speed enhancement comes after the Central Railway recently fortified and upgraded

tracks along the Wardha-Badnera section, covering a stretch of 95.44 km. Consequently, these thirty trains will now be able to operate at increased speeds on this particular segment. Additionally, track improvements have been completed on several other sections, such as Igatpuri-Nashik-Bhusaval-Akola-Badnera (526.65 km), Pune-Daund (75.59 km), and Itarsi-Nagpur-Wardha-Ballarshah (509.05 km). This enhancement covers a total stretch of 1206.73 km. Ongoing efforts to boost train speeds on the Daund-Solapur-Gulbarga-Wadi section, spanning 337.44

km are underway. This initiative aims to facilitate faster travel for these long-distance trains reducing travel time, said a CR official.
