Nath assures industrialists of redressing problems

Chief Minister Kamal Nath on Thursday assured the Pithampur Audhyogik Sangathan that the government has already started acting on 80 percent of the grievances and suggestions of the association.

In a meeting with Pithampur Audhyogik Sangathan at Brilliant Convention Centre, he said, "We have already started working on 80 percent of the grievances and the result would be seen soon. I will take another meeting with the industrialists and officials to solve the remaining 20 percent issues at the earliest." He said that the government wanted to prepare a friendly environment for industrialists so that the youngsters get employment and prosperity prevails in the state.

"Our priority is to solve the issues of the new investors as well as of the existing industries at the ear-



liest. I expect the association to inform me about the issues and problems of the industries regularly," he said. Meanwhile, President of Pithampur Sudhyogik Sangathan Dr Gautam Kothari submitted a 22-point demand memorandum to the chief minister and expressed gratitude that he has motivated the investors and industries in his short eight months tenure. The main demands of the association was merger of ministries of small and large industries, centralization of Industrial Area De-

velopment Corporation, implementation of MP Investment Act 2015, resolving issues in labour laws, development of transport park in Pithampur, easy building permission among others

Investment of Rs 1 lakh cr has come in 8 months: CS

Chief Secretary Sudhi Ranjan Mohanty on Thursday said that investment of about 1 lakh crore has been confirmed in the state since the Kamal Nath government has come to power. Addressing a press conference, Mohanty said that more investment will come to the state soon as the chief minister has tried to make an industry and industrialist friendly atmosphere.

"With these investments, about 2.10 lakh people will get employment in the state. In the last investor summit held in 2016, MoUs of about Rs 5 lakh crore were signed but only Rs 1.20 lakh crore was investment made, which comes to a conversion rate of 23-24 percent," he said. The CS said that this time, they did not want 'quantity' but 'quality' and that is why they had invited only those who were serious about investing.

"We don't want crowd so we asked only the No 1 or No 2 of the major indus-

Mohanty said that as many as 267 movies have been shot in the state but the production houses had to face trouble in getting permission from various department. "We have started a separate cell in tourism department which will help the production houses in getting permission and promote entertainment sector in the state," he added.

tries to come in the summit so that decision making can be done immediately and positively. We have invited about 1500 industrialists of the country and received confirmation of about 900 industrialists which was an unexpected surprise for us as it was believed that due to the present conditions, the participation would be low," he added. Mohanty said that the

main focus of the government will on food procession sector as the state has already won Krishi Karman Award for five times. "Some big industrialists have also shown interest in the same and soon they will invest. Similarly, we have focus on solar and renewable energy sector, and warehouse and logistics sectors too because MP touches the borders of about 4-5 states and touch-

es 50 percent of the population of the country," he added.

Tourism is also the second most employment generation sector after construction as MP has many places like Mahakaleshwar, Omkareshwar, Maheshwar and Orchha.

"We also have the highest number of animal parks in the country and even bagged the tag of Tiger State. However, state couldn't get much recognition for the same and we will focus to develop the sector," he added.

The CS also mentioned about the government's step to prepare separate policies for every sector which was made on the suggestions of the industrialists and people working in those fields. He said they were appointing a co-ordination officer in each sector who will work as bridge between industrialist and government.
