

S Korea sheds light on frantic acts by North to curb virus

SEOUL: North Korean leader Kim Jong Un has ordered at least two people executed, banned fishing at sea and locked down capital Pyongyang as part of frantic efforts to guard against the coronavirus and its economic damage, South Korea's spy agency told lawmakers on Friday, Kim's

government also ordered diplomats overseas to refrain from any acts that could provoke the United States as it's worried about President-elect Joe Biden's possible new approach on North Korea, lawmakers told reporters after attending a private briefing by the National Intelligence Service.



TRUMP WILL EXIT IF ELECTORAL COLLEGE SAYS HE HAS LOST

US President Donald Trump said for the first time that he will leave the White House if the Electoral College declares Joe Biden as the winner, but made clear he is not prepared to "concede" the election. Trump, a Republican, has refused to accept defeat in the November 3 presidential election, and told reporters on Thursday that it would be "hard" to concede to Biden, a Democrat. "Certainly I will, and you know that," Trump said when asked by a reporter about leaving the White House if Biden is declared the winner on December 14. "I will and, you know that." "It's going to be a very hard thing to concede because we know there was massive fraud," Trump said, once again repeating the unsubstantiated claims of voter fraud. Meanwhile, President Trump blasted a White House correspondent during a testy exchange on Thursday, branding the reporter 'lightweight' for speaking over him

to ask if he would concede the election to President-elect Joe Biden. "I'm the President of the United States. Don't ever talk to the president that way," Trump told Reuters correspondent Jeff Mason on Thursday during a heated question-and-answer session in the White House, reports The Daily Mail. The 538-member Electoral College is scheduled to meet on December 14 and is expected to formally declare the 78-year-old former vice president as the 46th US President. Under the US electoral system, voters do not directly choose the president. Instead, they vote for 538 officials, who are allocated to American states based on their population size. Biden leads Trump 306 votes to 232 under the Electoral College system used to pick US presidents.

Biden's tally is far more than the 270 needed to win the race for the White House, and he also leads the popular vote by more than six million. In his Thanksgiving Day remarks, Trump, however, said it will be a mistake if the Electoral College were to elect Biden. "It's going to be a very hard thing to concede," Trump told reporters when asked during a press call at the White House what he will do if the Electoral College elects Biden. "If they do, they made a mistake," he said. On his plans for his last Thanksgiving in the White House, Trump said, "You can't say what's first or last." It might be the "first one of the second term." Earlier this week, Trump allowed the official start of Biden's transition to power without conceding de-

feat. Biden due to be sworn in as president on January 20. However, election officials in key battleground states have declared Biden the winner, giving him an unofficial 306-232 edge in the Electoral College that determines the outcome of US presidential contests. "This was a massive fraud," Trump said of the election. "We are like a Third World country," he said, referring to the voting infrastructure. "No one wants to see the kind of fraud this election has come to represent," he added. State officials have said they do not have any evidence of large-scale voter fraud. "I don't know what is going to happen. I know one thing, Joe Biden did not get 80 million votes," Trump said, adding that Biden didn't beat former president Barack Obama's vote total with black voters. Trump's efforts to challenge the results in key states in courts have so far failed.

Nasty fight: Punches & flying pig guts in Taiwan parliament

AGENCIES / Taipei Lawmakers in Taiwan got into a fist fight and threw pig guts at each other Friday over a soon-to-be enacted policy that would allow imports of US pork and beef. Premier Su Tseng-chang was due to give a regularly scheduled policy report to lawmakers on Friday morning about the pork policy when opposition party lawmakers from the Nationalist party, also known as the KMT, blocked his attempt to speak by dumping bags of pig organs. Legislators from the ruling Dem-

ocratic Progressive Party attempted to stop them, resulting in chaos and an exchange of punches. A DPP lawmaker wrestled a KMT lawmaker to the floor in the scuffle. President Tsai Ing-wen's administration lifted a long-standing ban on imports of US pork and beef in August, in a move seen as one of the first steps toward possibly negotiating a bilateral trade agreement with the US. The ban is due to be lifted in January. That decision has met with fierce opposition, both from the KMT and individual citizens. The new policy allows imports of pork with acceptable residues of some

farmers add to animal feed that promotes the growth of lean meat. On Sunday, thousands of people marched in Taipei to protest the imports. US pork would account for a small percentage of the island's consumption, but the Nationalist party has seized on the issue in an effort to mobilise support following successive failures at the polls. "When you were in the opposition, you were against US pork, now that you're in power, you've become a supporter of US pork," said KMT legislator Lin Weichou, who led the group of lawmakers protesting the policy on Friday.

UK PM defends the new three-tier system as the best chance of avoiding a third complete national lockdown



ADITI KHANNA London UK Prime Minister Boris Johnson was on Friday fighting back rebels from within his own Conservative Party who are opposed to most of England being put into the toughest two tiers of high COVID-19 alert after the country's second stay-at-home lockdown ends next Wednesday. In a Downing Street briefing on Thursday after he ended his self-isolation on being in contact with a COVID-19 positive MP, Johnson defended the three-tier system as the best chance of avoiding a third complete national lockdown in the New Year.

"If we ease off now, we risk losing control of this virus all over again, casting aside our hard won gains, and forcing us back into a New Year national lockdown with all the damage that would mean," said Johnson. "Under our Winter Plan, England will return to a tiered system of local restrictions. Our decisions on which area enters which tier are based on public health advice according to five indicators: cases across all ages, especially the over 60s, the rate by which cases are rising or falling, the percentage of those tested in a local population who have COVID-19, and the pressure on the NHS," he said. "There is no logic whatsoever in

having a month of lockdown only for people to have to live under an even more severe set of restrictions afterwards," said Harriet Baldwin, the Tory MP for West Worcestershire, which has been placed in Tier 2. Johnson has a comfortable 80-strong majority in the House of Commons, but if 40 of his own MPs vote down his Winter Plan when it comes for a vote next Tuesday, he will have to rely on support from the Opposition to get it through. And, the Labour Party is expected to decide only early next week whether to back the plans after consultation with government coronavirus experts.

Germany crosses grisly milestone of 1mn cases BERLIN: Germany hit another grim milestone in the coronavirus pandemic on Friday, ticking above 1 million confirmed cases of COVID-19. The Robert Koch Institute, the country's disease control center, said Germany's 16 states reported 22,806 cases overnight for a total since the start of the outbreak of 1,006,394. Despite the high number of infections, Germany has seen fewer deaths than many other European countries, with 15,586 - compared with more than 50,000 in Britain, Italy and France, for example. The country is almost a month in to a so-called "wave-breaker" shutdown instituted on November 2 after an alarming rise in daily figures to new record highs. Friday's total was slightly less than that reported a week ago and officials say the new measures have succeeded in halting the surge. But Chancellor Angela Merkel and state government ministers decided earlier this week to extend the shutdown well into December and add more restrictions to try to now bring the numbers down to below 50 per 100,000 inhabitants each week. It's only at that level or below that officials say they can effectively trace outbreaks to implement quarantines when necessary.
