Eligible persons to get free house site pattas: Collector

Karur, Nov 3: Priority will be given to all eligible persons with priceless house site pattas, said District Collector S Malarvizhy. Speaking to mediapersons after taking charge as new district head, she said that the role of media is vital for the district administration and added that they should extend cooperation in the overall development of the district.

On Tamil Nadu government's objective of ensuring priceless house site pattas to everyone, she said that enumeration is underway through revenue department for distributing priceless house site pattas and



added that she will leave no stone unturned to see those eligible persons sans dwellings get priceless house site pattas soon. Meanwhile, she underlined the need to extend help to those eligible persons left

uncared for with old age pension and widow pension. All out efforts will be made to ensure those people get all government assistance. During monsoon, she said that sewage channels will be cleaned up regularly on a warfooting to clear the debris and plastic wastes paving the way for free flow of sewage water. Necessary steps would be taken to see banned plastics aren't in use in the district.

Collector said that a new app will be developed soon exclusively for grievance redressal and added that action will be initiated against those putting up flex boards on roads obstructing

traffic. Based on high court ruling, she said that penal action would be taken up against those violating the government directives.

Though COVID is under control, she said that there is chances of virus spreading during festival time where there is likely to be heavy rush at commercial establishments like textile, jewellery and sweet shops and hence it is advisable for public to adhere to the COVID safety protocol while venturing out to shopping hub for purchases during festival time.

Fourth freight train with harvester machines leaves Chinna Salem

Salem, Nov 3: Southern Railway takes numerous efforts to ensure unhindered movement of a variety of essential commodities and various other goods and materials. Overcoming all odds caused by the covid pandemic, Southern Railway transports raw materials and finished products which help the traders, businessmen, farmers and the people at large. These activities aid the growth of the economy, too.

The Business Development Unit of Salem Division of Southern Railway is always on the lookout to sustain and improve the commercial activities of the division. Untiring efforts by the Business Development Unit of Salem Division get new streams of freight traffic.

Recently, Salem Division transported harvester machines from Chinna Salem to Nalgonda in Telangana and Surathkal



in Karnataka. Moreover, mosquito nets, loaded on 42 wagons, were transported from Karur to Mancheswar in Bhubaneswar, Odisha. And, yesterday, in a novel initiative, boxes of toned milk, weighing 138 tonnes, were transported from Salem to Dimapur in Nagaland in a special parcel train, comprising general second class coaches. For the first time in Southern Railway, general second class coaches were utilized to move parcels.

In continuation of such efforts, Salem division is transporting harvester

machines from Chinna Salem to Eluru in Andhra Pradesh. 83 harvester machines, loaded on 32 wagons, are being moved from Chinna Salem in Salem Division to Eluru in Andhra Pradesh. This is the fourth train to leave from Chinna Salem carrying harvester machines.

Earlier, one freight train carried harvester machines to Nalgonda in Telangana and two freight trains carried harvester machines to Surathkal in Karnataka. This initiative will be very beneficial to farmers and give a fillip to agricultural activities.

Erode collector distributes welfare aid at mass contact program

Erode, Nov 3: District Collector C Kathiravan said that instead of public knocking at the doors of the government departments for their needs, the officials visit the people at the designated panchayat on a particular day to redress the grievances besides distributing welfare assistance to beneficiaries.

That's the main objective of Mass Contact Programme, he said adding that all department officials converged at Brahmana Periya Agraharam and BS Agraharam, Nanjai Dalawaipalayam and Vairapalayam area wherein electronic ration cards were distributed to family heads. Welfare assistance were given by MLAs K V Ramalingam and K S Thennarasu.

During the mass contact programme, he said



that petitions regarding drinking water, street lights and road facility were received and the concerned officials were directed to look into the petitions and redress them soon. Orders were given to 22 beneficiaries to avail widow pension to the tune of Rs 2.64 lakh while 50 beneficiaries were given electronic ration cards besides a subsidy amount of Rs 40,479 was given to a beneficiary for setting

up drip irrigation for the farmland and it was given under Horticulture department.

About 145 beneficiaries received government welfare assistance to the tune of Rs 4,17,911 including 69 elderly persons were given dhothies and sarees as part of Deepavali festival at the meet. Collector received 126 petitions at the mass contact programme wherein he directed the

concerned officials to take appropriate action on it soon.
