

# FINANCIAL AID TO THOSE WHO LOST BREAD EARNER TO COVID SMC not needed if spouse is alive

The Delhi Government will provide financial assistance to the families who lost their bread earners due to Covid-19. As per the Mukhyamantri Covid-19 Parivar Arthik Sahayata Yojana, Surviving Member Certificates (SMCs) are no longer required for application in case one of the spouses is alive.

As Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal has always assured the people of Delhi, that the Government will stand with the people in their time of grief. It is our duty to help the families who have lost their loved ones in this pandemic in every

way possible," Kailash Gahlot, Revenue Minister said after chairing a high-level meeting with department officials to review the "Mukhyamantri Covid-19 Parivar Arthik Sahayata Yojana". The meeting was attended by Divisional Commissioner, District Magistrate (HQ) and all the District Magistrates (DMS).

During the meeting, it has been decided that under this Yojana there will no longer be a need for obtaining SMC from the applicant in cases where one of the spouses is alive. However, the SMC will remain in force for the grant of ex-gratia for other applicants.

In cases where the

deceased was a single parent, the surviving children are entitled to the ex-gratia which is to be equally distributed among all children. However for that, the name of the applicant should be reflected in the SMC. Similarly if the deceased is unmarried or is a minor son/daughter, the father or mother of the deceased will get relief under the scheme subject to their name appearing in SMC

The Mukhyamantri Covid-19 Parivar Arthik Sahayata Yojana was started by the Delhi Government in June, 2021 to provide relief to the survivors of the deceased who died of Covid-19.

# Parents laud impact of Mega PTM

Parents of Delhi Government school students said that the 'Mega PTM' increased their participation in the overall development of their children. As per the research conducted by State Council for Educational Research and Training (SCERT) on Mega PTMs, 97 per cent of the parents were satisfied with the initiative. The Director of SCERT Delhi and his team handed over a copy of this research to the Deputy Chief Minister and Education Minister Manish Sisodia.

Sisodia said that research and training are two important

things in the realm of SCERT. "In the last several years, the role of SCERT has been more prominent in the field of training and the field of research could not receive the due attention. However, now SCERT Delhi has demonstrated that it is prepared to work in the field of research," Sisodia said.

Appreciating the Director of SCERT Delhi and his team for this step in the field of research, he said, "This research done by SCERT will prove to be helpful in adopting necessary changes in educational programs and policies."

The basic objective of this research published in the context of the Mega PTM is to examine the awareness among parents and teachers, to understand their perception about Mega PTM, to establish the dif-

ference between the perception of parents and teachers about Mega PTM and to understand methods for better implementation. In this research it was found that mass media had played an important role in making parents aware about Mega PTM.

During the PTM, 71 per cent of the parents and 61 per cent of the teachers discussed the regularity of children in schools, academic activities at school and home, improvement of children in learning level, children's health and hygiene, home environment and activities of children. Most of the parents and teachers agreed that Mega PTM will increase the regularity of children in schools and their academic performance in the future.

# Prof Yogesh Singh appointed as the new V-C of DU

At present, Professor Pooran Chand Joshi is the interim Vice-Chancellor. He was appointed to the post following then V-C Professor Yogesh Kumar Tyagi's suspension. The Union Education Ministry said that Yogesh Singh has been appointed as the V-C of Delhi University. "The Hon'ble Visitor appoints Vice-Chancellors of two Central Universities: University of Delhi (Prof Yogesh Singh); Dr Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya, Sagar (Prof Neelima Gupta)," the Ministry said in a tweet.

Professor Singh joined the DTU in 2017. He served as the

Director of Netaji Subhas Institute of Technology from 2014-2017, The V-C of Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda between 2011 and 14, and as Dean of Information Technology at Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, or IP University from 2001 to 2006. He received his M.Tech. (Electronics) and Communication Engineering) and Ph.D. (Computer Engineering) degrees from National Institute of Technology, Kurukshetra, Haryana. He has supervised 23 Ph.Ds in the area of Software Engineering.

# EDMC brings out new policy for spas

The East Delhi Municipal Corporation (EDMC) has approved the proposal for allowing spa centres to function in its areas with certain guidelines, the civic body said in a statement.

According to the new guidelines, cross-gender massage will not be allowed in spa centres and spa facilities will not be provided behind closed doors. A senior EDMC official said that rooms in these centres shall have no latches and bolts inside the doors.

"A series of guidelines have been issued for them before they start function. Now the new rules will be applicable to all the spa centres running in the East Corporation jurisdic-

tion," he said. Mayor of East Delhi Shyam Sundar Agarwal has given anticipatory approval to this proposal. Talking about the issue, Agarwal said that it has been made mandatory to note down the details of all the customers in a register containing their contact details and ID proof. Apart from this, spa centres can remain open only between 9 am to 9 pm.

The Mayor also informed that the centres will have separate changing rooms for men and women and the premises will not be used for residential purposes. Chairman of the Standing Committee, Beer Singh Panwar informed that under the new guidelines, it is now necessary for the masseur to have a degree/diploma or certificate in physiotherapy.

# AAP claims NMC selling schools to coaching centres; BJP refutes charge

Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) senior leader Saurabh Bhardwaj on Wednesday accused the BJP-ruled municipal corporations of having floated tenders to sell 14 MCD schools to private coaching centres.

Bhardwaj said that while the number of students studying in Delhi Government schools is exponentially rising, the headcount in MCD schools has reduced from three lakh to two lakh thirty thousand in the last few years. The AAP leader said that the BJP has given away MCD school buildings to its own people. "Private coaching institutes will now run in MCD schools. There are only 30-40

children left in several schools of the MCD and they do not even have enough students to run those schools. It is important to mention here that the Corporations keep claiming they do not have enough land for Mohalla Clinics but sell school buildings to private players," he added.

Reacting to this, Delhi BJP Spokesperson Praveen Shankar Kapoor said that the allegation is baseless as North DMC is not leasing or selling any of its schools to private coaching centres. "The civic body has tens of school buildings lying empty as certain areas especially in the City Zone have gone commercial with very little population left thus rendering schools useless," he said.

# Delhi 5-star hotel chef arrested for snatching

Delhi Police has arrested a 35-year-old chef of a five-star hotel for multiple cases of snatching in South Delhi. Police said that the accused had a good salary but he took to snatching to pay off his gambling debts.

The accused has been identified as Harish, a resident of Sangam Vihar area, Police said that Harish, who holds degrees in BA and hotel management, worked at a five-star hotel near the IGI Airport.

According to Atul Kumar Thakur, the Deputy Commissioner of Police (DCP), Spouth district, after receiving a tip off, Harish was arrested from Neb Sarai area on Tuesday evening where he had

gone for more snatchings.

"Harish especially targeted women going for a walk or travelling to offices near Saket Metro Station. Other times, he would lurk in the park adjoining the metro station or at Ambedkar Nagar bus stand on Mehrauli-Badarpur (MB) Road," said the DCP.

"Finding himself trapped, the accused took out his country-made pistol but the police personnel overpowered him and snatched the firearm from his hand," he said.

"After his arrest, Harish disclosed that he had sold three snatched gold chains to a goldsmith in Sangam Vihar area. On the basis of his testimony, police arrested Rajender Aggarwal for buying the stolen property," the DCP added.

# SDMC launches portal to give permission for film shooting in its areas

South Delhi Municipal Corporation (SDMC) has launched a portal to grant permission for film shooting in its areas.

A senior SDMC official said that under Ease of Doing Business, a 'single window' policy for online approval of film shooting is also being developed for various agencies of Delhi and Delhi Tourism and Transport Development Corporation (DTTDC) has been appointed the nodal agency.

A senior SDMC official said that the SDMC has formulated a policy for allowing shooting films and the portal is

developed for smooth facilitation of the entire process of granting approval. "Applicants will have to apply through SDMC's official website. After submitting relevant documents and paying the permission fee, approval of film shooting will be given by the Directorate of Press and Information in a period of three days. The newly developed system is transparent and easy to apply as it has no manual interference. Earlier, approval was being given manually," he said.

Various agencies like Delhi Traffic Police, ASI, local bodies of Delhi, DMRC, Railways, DIAL, GMR Group, Escon, etc have been working at one platform.

# Govt committed to provide health insurance to scribes: Director, IPRD

Director of the Directorate of Information and Public Relations Shashi Prakash Singh

has said that the Chief Minister wants to provide health insurance to the media personnel. The government is committed to this. He was speaking in a

meeting held on Wednesday with media representatives regarding the draft health insurance scheme at Sookhna Bhawan.

Singh said that the government wants to take views from all the media personnel. In this regard, representatives of two insurance companies have also been called, who are doing the work of health insurance of media personnel in the neighbouring states. He invited media persons to share their suggestions regarding

insurance company or terms of insurance with the Directorate. He said that soon the rules of health insurance will be prepared. After that, once again the opinion of the journalists will be taken on this and after that it will be implemented.

Journalists also gave their suggestions on this occasion. It was suggested not to charge the insurance premium or to fix the amount at 10 per cent of the total premium. At the same time, emphasis was laid on connecting journalists

of regional areas including the city with the insurance scheme. Along with this, it was also suggested to increase the amount of insurance up to Rs 10 lakh.

Deputy Director of Directorate of Information and Public Relations Shalini Verma, Assistant Director Avinash Kumar, representatives of United India Insurance Company, National Insurance Company and representatives of various media organizations were present in the meeting.

# Judicial commission probe in Rupa Tirkey case continues

The one member judicial inquiry commission headed by former Jharkhand chief justice Vinod Kumar Gupta has informed through the public notice that so far 18 persons have submitted their statements and claims regarding the suspicious death of Jharkhand Police ASI Rupa Tirkey.

The public notice further states that anybody willing to cross-examine any of these persons can make a written request with the commission by October 15. It has further stated that a copy of affidavit and details of these persons can be procured from the secretary, Akhilesh Kumar Sinha.

In case nobody turn-up to cross examine the commission will hold its final meeting on November 18 at the Excise Building and a report will be submitted to the state government.

# Twenty six year-old Rupa Tirkey was posted at Mahila police station in Sahebganj district

The commission was formed by the state government to ensure a fair probe in the matter at a time when Jharkhand police was also carrying out an investigation.

Twenty six year-old Rupa Tirkey was posted at Mahila police station in Sahebganj district. She was found hanging at her official quarter in the morning of May 3. While the police initially concluded it as the case of suicide it later arrested her colleague SK Kanaujia for abetment of suicide. But the family blamed their daughter was murdered by some influential persons and moved a petition for the CBI probe at Jharkhand High Court.

The single bench of Justice

Sanjay Kumar Dwivedi ordered the CBI probe and the CBI has taken over the investigation also.

Now the question is being raised whether the inquiry being carried by the judicial commission legally stands when the CBI has already started the probe.

"I don't know if the probe commission still exists because the CBI is investigating the case so there can't be any parallel probe. Also under CRPC such an inquiry commission has no that kind of status. To my knowledge, in criminal cases like this judicial inquiry can't be ordered," said Rajiv Kumar, lawyer of Jharkhand High Court.

Meanwhile, in another development, the CBI is likely to question the then Sahebganj DSP (headquarter) Sanjay Kumar who for a short duration had headed SIT which was investigating the Rupa Tirkey case. He was transferred to Giridih.

# JSLPS inks MoU for development of PVTGs

Jharkhand State Livelihood Promotion Society signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with NGO Vasani to include the families of Primitive Vulnerable Tribal Groups of the State in the mainstream of development by connecting them with a strong livelihood through Jharkhand Millet Mission. The MoU was signed by the Chief Executive Officer Nancy Sahay and the Director of Vasani, Dr. Sabyasachi Das at the State Office of JSLPS at Hehal.

Under this non-financial agreement, Vasani will work to improve the livelihood of PVTGs within the scope of the UDAN project run by JSLPS. To revive the cultivation of honey, work will be done to increase the income of tribal families by connecting them with improved cultivation of honey.

After signing the MoU, Sahay said that Jharkhand Millet Mission will be

launched, through which the goal of making the State malnutrition free along with livelihood for tribal families will also be achieved.

Vasani will provide technical assistance from millet production to processing, marketing etc. This initiative will help in making the PVTG families of the State prosperous by linking them with the means of sustainable livelihood. Sabyasachi Das, Director of Vasani, said that Vasani will help JSLPS in the implementation of Millet Mission in the State and will help in providing marketing and processing facilities from honey production. Through this initiative, the Birhor, Asur, Sabar, Pahariya, Korba, Birjia and Parhiya tribal groups will get direct benefits.

Through this initiative, an increase in the income of PVTG families will also be ensured by establishing a model of entrepreneurship through backyard poultry in 20 blocks of the State.
