# GST collections touch Rs. 1.55 lakh cr in January 2023

New Delhi, Feb 1: Goods and Services Tax (GST) collections for January 2023 stood at Rs 1,55,922 crore, 4 per cent higher than Rs 1,49,507 crore collected in December 2022.

January's collections are second only to Rs 1.68 lakh crore gross GST collections recorded in April 2022.

GST collections have crossed

the Rs 1.50 lakh crore mark for the third time in 2022-23, official sources said.

Out of the Rs 1,55,922 crore GST collections for January 2023, CGST was Rs 28,963 crore, SGST was Rs 36,730 crore and IGST stood at Rs 79,599 crore.

The government has settled Rs 38,507 crore towards CGST and Rs 32,624 crore towards SGST from

IGST as regular settlement.

The total revenue of Centre and the states in January 2023 after regular settlement is Rs 67,470 crore for CGST and Rs 69,354 crore for the SGST.

Revenues in the current financial year up to January 2023 are 24 per cent higher than the GST revenues collected up to January 2022.

# Adoor steps down as chairman of Kerala film institute

Chennai, Feb 1: Veteran filmmaker Adoor Gopalakrishnan stepped down as chairman of KR Narayanan National Institute of Visual Science and Arts (KRNNIVSA) on Tuesday.

Since December 2022, the students of have been on an indefinite protest demanding the resignation of the institute's director Shankar Mohan who faced allegations of caste discrimination. The students alleged that Shankar, a former actor and filmmaker,

has exhibited caste-based discrimination on the campus on multiple occasions and asked conservancy workers to clean the toilets of the director's private residence.

The allegation also includes Shankar breaching students' reservation rules. Meanwhile, Gopalakrishnan supported the director and refuted the allegations. He was criticised for the same. Following that, on January 21, Shankar resigned as the director.

# DMK planning to use fake voter ID cards in Erode East: AIADMK

Chennai, Feb 1: The AIADMK on Tuesday complained to Chief Electoral Officer Satyabrata Sahoo that the DMK was engaged in the production of fake voter identity cards in the Erode (East) Assembly constituency, where a by-election will be held on February 27.

D. Jayakumar, the party's organisation secretary and former Minister, told reporters that the authorities should ensure no fake cards were used on the day of polling. He accused the ruling party of planning to "capture" booths.

Referring to an audio clip of a speech alleged to be of Local Administration Minister K.N. Nehru, Mr. Jayakumar said this showed the ruling party was going to use the "money power". He urged the Election Commission to see to it that the by-election was held in a free and fair manner.

Meanwhile, a group of office-bearers from Tamil Nadu Bharatiya Janata Party lodged a complaint with Mr. Sahoo, alleging that the DMK and its allies were planning to distribute money to voters in the Erode (East) Assembly constituency.

Minister K.N. Nehru were reportedly discussing plans to distribute cash.

Thirupathy said his party told the CEO that the brazen manner in which the two were discussing in the video was an indication that the DMK and its allies were planning to distribute cash for votes on a large scale with the involvement of senior Ministers. The BJP demanded action against Mr. Nehru and Mr. Elangovan.
